MOTION TO EXTEND STAY FOR 45 DAYS AS TO FOUNDING PARTNERS ENTITIES

Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission hereby moves to extend the stay of all deadlines in this matter as to Defendant Founding Partners Capital Management Co. and Relief Defendants Founding Partners Stable-Value Fund, LP, Founding Partners Stable-Value Fund II, LP, Founding Partners Global Fund, LTD., and Founding Partners Hybrid-Value Fund, LP (collectively, the "Founding Partners Entities") for an additional forty-five (45) days. The Commission has conferred with counsel for the Receiver, who does not oppose this request.

1. Daniel S. Newman, the Court-appointed Receiver for the Founding Partners Entities [D.E. 73], is in the process of carrying out his court-appointed duties on behalf of investors. Among other things, the Receiver is actively involved in litigating a related action before this

Court entitled Daniel S. Newman, as Receiver for Founding Partners Capital Management

Company, et al. v. Sun Capital, Inc., et al., U.S. District Court, Middle District of Florida, Case

No. 2:09-CV-445-FTM-99SPC ("Receivership Litigation").

2. On April 8, 2010, the Court entered an order staying all deadlines for 120 days in this

matter [D.E. 207]. That stay was subsequently twice extended, consistent with the stay in the

Receivership Litigation, until February 22, 2011 [D.E. 240, 264]. On February 22, 2011, the

Court granted the Commission's motion to extend the stay as to the Founding Partners Entities

for an additional 60 days, or until April 23, 2011, again consistent with the stay in the

Receivership Litigation. D.E. 276].

3. It is the Commission's understanding that settlement discussions are still ongoing in

the Receivership Litigation and that the Receiver intends to seek an extension of the stay in that

case for an additional 45 days. Accordingly, the Commission hereby seeks an extension of the

stay against the Founding Partner Entities in this case for an additional 45 days as well.

CONCLUSION

For all the foregoing reasons, the Court should continue the stay in this action as to the

Founding Partners Entities for an additional 45 days.
